OUR VISION

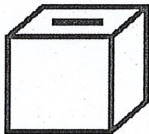

- *Building strategic bridges between our church and the communities in which we live, work, and play.

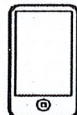

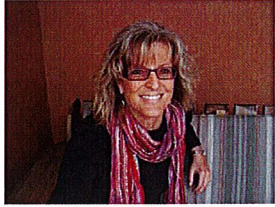
